



To remove the StartupCheckLibrary.dll error, first download Autoruns:

https://live.sysinternals.com/Autoruns.exe

- Run Autoruns.exe as administrator.
- In the Filterbox up top Enter: startupcheck
- You should see a Task Scheduler entry: \Microsoft\Windows\Application **Experience\StartupCheckLibrary**
- Right click on this entry and **Delete**.

...and that's the end of the error.

BTW Ignore any advice that recommends restoring this dll from quarantine. It's a CoinMiner and you really don't want it!
