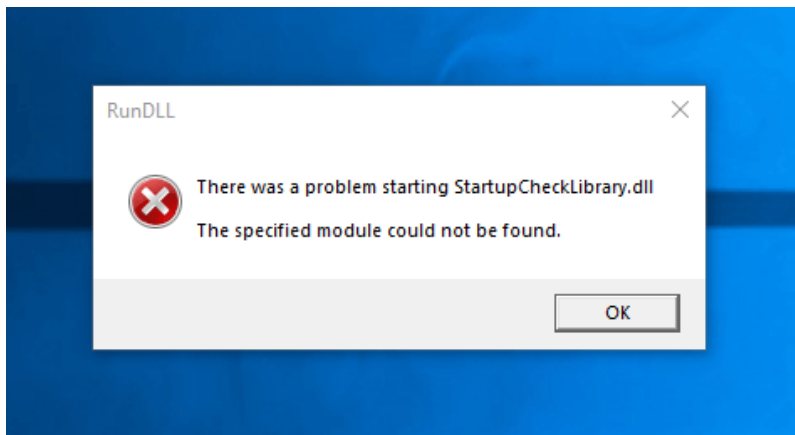

To remove the StartupCheckLibrary.dll error, first download Autoruns:

<https://live.sysinternals.com/Autoruns.exe>

- Run Autoruns.exe as administrator.
- In the Filterbox up top Enter: **startupcheck**
- You should see a Task Scheduler entry: **\Microsoft\Windows\Application Experience\StartupCheckLibrary**
- Right click on this entry and **Delete**.


...and that's the end of the error.

BTW Ignore any advice that recommends restoring this dll from quarantine. It's a **CoinMiner** and you really don't want it!
